Is your Drascombe centreplate starting to show ageing or corrosion?

My Lugger is a 1987 Mk2 and due the centreplate arm breaking off we have found that some (if not all) older centreplates had the arm welded on before galvanising . As the galvanising is penetrated by water the weld rusts causing it to give way, at which time the arm breaks off, the plate rotates off the retaining pin and it sinks at the speed of light!



What is the answer?: we are now able to offer centreplates cut as one piece from 304 or 316 stainless steel. Each plate is precision cut by laser to your specification and the leading edge is radiused for streamlining .

Example price for MK2 replacement plate in SS304 (with arm 57mm over standard to better clear the housing and improve raising) is £298.00 ex delivery. (galvanised steel is sold elsewhere for £308.00). The SS plate is approx 3kg heavier than mild steel.
